Each 4-H member showing in this department is responsible for reading and complying with the General Rules for the Clark County Fair (beginning of Exhibitor Handbook), 4-H Rules and Regulations printed at the beginning of 4-H section, and the special rules and regulations of this department.

RULES & REGULATIONS:

1. All entries must be sent to the WSU/Clark County Extension Office by June 30, 2017 by 5 pm. No Late Entries Will Be Accepted – NO EXCEPTIONS.
2. Animals will be accepted at the Clark County Fair starting on Sunday, August 6, after 8 pm.
3. **ASTM-SEI #1163 approved helmets are mandatory for all exhibitors**
4. **Fitting & Showing is mandatory for every horse in every event.**
Prequalifying is mandatory for hunt seat equitation over fences and trail/practical horsemanship.
5. State Fair participants must use the same horse they qualified on in the Clark County Fair Division for the State Fair Class.
