This contest will be open to any 4-H member currently enrolled in the Clark County 4-H Program. There will be a Junior/Novice, Intermediate and Senior division.

This event will be used to select Intermediate and Senior team members to represent Clark County in WA State 4-H Fair and/or out of county contests.

Junior/Novice (first time Intermediates and Seniors) are encouraged to enter in the Novice division; however, they will be ineligible for State Fair as this will be a training session for this group.

A member shall place according to his or her judgment classes in Beef, Sheep, Swine, and Meat Goats from any breeds and classes available, and shall be prepared to give reasons either oral or written.

BRING A PENCIL!

All 4-H animals must be available for use in Clark County Fair Judging Contests including performance, obedience, or type judging classes. Refusal by the exhibitor to provide an animal when requested by show superintendent without adequate reason will result in forfeiture of all awards and premiums and continued participation in this year's show. A "Best Oral Reasons" Rosette ribbon will be awarded at Junior, Intermediate and Senior levels.
