DIVISION 93: INDIVIDUAL EDUCATIONAL DISPLAY

The exhibit shall be a display emphasizing student performance and learning. Students wishing to exhibit a large educational booth, may request one of the unused chapter display booths (if available) from the FFA Superintendent for this purpose. These exhibits will be judged by the Chapter Educational Booth criteria and be awarded premiums equal to Chapter Educational Booths. The display materials shall be accompanied by a project description listing the purpose, the process or methods followed, and a summary of the outcome of the activity. The display will be judged on its educational value and the message it conveys to the public.

All booths shall be complete and ready for judging by 8 p.m. on Thursday, August 3.
