Deadline – pre-sign up form must be in the WSU/Clark County Extension Office is by the last business day of June.

Must use your own machine, they will not be provided. Any garment related to clothing construction, may be sewn. There will be a three (3) hour time limit to complete the garment. Participants may be asked to give a verbal explanation for information to the public. Garment will be modeled before the judge when completed.

The verbal explanation should include information concerning what is being made, various time saving techniques, why fabric was selected or advantages of the particular fiber content. A worksheet will be sent to the exhibitor after pre-registering for this activity. The worksheet must be given to the judge at the beginning of the activity. Call the superintendent for further help and information about the activity.
