

Official Contest Rules for “Passport to Fun”

No purchase is necessary to enter.

This contest is void where prohibited by law.

Eligibility: Clark County Fair’s “Passport to Fun” is open to legal residents of the United States who are between the ages of 2 and 12 years old. Employees and immediate family members of employees of Fairgrounds Site Management Group and its contractors are not eligible.

Prizes/Odds of Winning: When passports are completed (after obtaining at least ten stamps) each kid turns it to the Lost Children’s Booth for a special prize and gets entered into the drawing for the GRAND PRIZE. Three grand prizes each prize is valued at \$325.00. Odds of winning are contingent upon the number of valid entries received. All federal, state, and local laws apply. Taxes, if any, are the sole responsibility of the prizewinner.

How to Enter:

1) Anyone who is eligible and collects at least 10 stamps out of participating departments during the 2010 Fair (August 6-15) can enter into the drawing for the **Passport to Fun Grand Prize**. One entry is allowed per child.

2) All entries become the property of Fairgrounds Site Management Group and will not be returned.

All of the personal information you provide will not be shared with anyone.

Prize Restrictions: This prize is not redeemable for cash, credit or merchandise. Fairgrounds Site Management Group reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

Selection of Winners: Winners will be randomly selected on, or immediately after August 16, 2009 from all valid entries received. In case of a dispute, the decision of Fairgrounds Site Management Group is final. The winners will be notified by email or US mail. The winner has 30 days to claim its prize. A new, randomly selected winner will be chosen if the winner fails to claim his or her prize or is otherwise unqualified.

By accepting the prize, the winner consents to the use of their name on the Clark County Fair web site and in any publicity carried out by Clark County Fair and its agents without compensation. If in the Clark County Fair's opinion there is any suspected or actual evidence of tampering with any portion of the contest, or if technical difficulties compromise the integrity of the contests, the Fairgrounds Site Management Group and its agents reserve the right to terminate the contest and conduct a random drawing to award the prize using all eligible entries received as of the termination date. Should the contest be terminated prior to the stated expiration date, notice will be posted on the Clark County Fair web site.
