Double your fun! All local winners are automatically entered into the National Amazing Scone Baking Race.

Bakers may enter as many different recipes as they wish as long as they provide 6 scones per recipe and a separate recipe page for each entry.

- All entries must be baked at home from scratch.
- All entries must bring proof of purchase of King Arthur Flour.
- All products should be covered and on a disposable container.
- No commercial scone mixes are allowed.
- Bring your scones to the floral entrance at the back of the Exhibition Hall, between 8:00 and 10:00 a.m. – Saturday, August 8, 2015.
- Products must be the work of the exhibitor. All entries must be baked by an amateur baker or specify professional baker.
- Entries must be accompanied by the recipe typed on a recipe card or an 8 1/2" x 11" paper, listing all ingredients and procedures used; name, address, phone and e-mail of entrant.
- All recipes become the property of the Amazing Scone Baking Race and subject to publication.
- The judges reserve the right to disqualify any exhibit.
- Scones will be judged on:
 - Taste (taste and aroma) 1-30 points
 - Originality, artistic flair 1-20 points
 - Ease of preparation /clarity of recipe 1-10 points
 - Overall Appearance 1-30 points

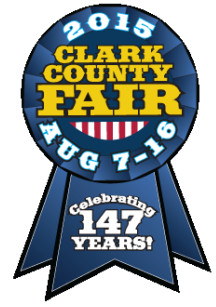

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HOW TO ENTER THE CONTEST

The contest is Saturday, August 8, 2015. On-site entry and scone delivery is from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m.

Optional online registration is available to speed the process. On the day of the contest, bring your scones to the dock at the Floral Entry of the Exhibition Hall at Clark County Fairgrounds. You may deliver the scones and your entry forms any time between 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. Judging is at 1:00 p.m.

IF NO ONLINE PRE-REGISTRATION:

That's just fine!! Just bring your completed entry form along with your scones to the fairgrounds as directed above. I'll be there to wish you a good morning and to label your baked goods for secrecy.

IF YOU CHOOSE TO PRE-REGISTER— There are **two ways** to pre-register:

By Internet: Submit your original recipe(s), in English, typed online on the Contest page at <http://www.AmazingSconeBakingRace.com> with your complete name, e-mail, mailing or street address, city, state, zip code, cell phone number, year of birth (over 18 or under 18). Online entries must be received by 11:59 a.m. Pacific Time on August 5, 2015.

The online registration form also includes an optional method to directly upload your scone recipe file.

Enter as often as you wish, but only one entry may qualify as a finalist. Each entry must be submitted separately.
