Clark County Fair Association Announces Concert Venue Changes for 2010

Ridgefield, WA -- With the successful venture of hosting two of the 2009 Clark County Fair concerts in the Amphitheater at Clark County, the Board of Directors and Fair Manager approved moving all of its 2010 Clark County Fair concerts to the Amphitheater at Clark County.

The fair will now bring in higher level national entertainment than the traditional free Grandstand concerts. Tickets for the concerts will be offered at tremendous family prices which will also include admission to the fair for that particular day.

These changes expand the entertainment opportunities for Fair goers – as the concerts in the grandstands will be replaced with new free afternoon and evening family entertainment. Having concerts in the grandstands limited the fair to one event a day in a venue that could bring a variety of free family entertainment to the Fair. Possibilities for the additional shows include additional rodeo events, a western show, additional fan favorite motorsports events, along with bringing back the extremely popular Knights of the Realm Medieval Jousting event that was new this year. The specific events will be finalized in the coming months.

“Moving the concerts to the Amphitheater at Clark County provides us the opportunity to work with bigger name acts, providing a better entertainment package for fair goers, all while utilizing both facilities to the fullest.” noted John Morrison, Clark County Fair Manager.
