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**OFFICIAL ADGA SHOW: ADGA rules shall govern.**

**The Junior and Senior Shows are separately sanctioned.  
The show order is subject to change to make the show run smoothly.**

### ONLINE ENTRIES

Entries can be submitted online at <https://clarkcofair.fairentry.com> beginning on **May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2026**, and ending on **July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2026, at 10 p.m.**

When you enter your exhibits online, your Exhibitor Number will be assigned to you automatically by the online software. Your entries will be received by the Premiums and Awards office, and your entry form and entry tags will be printed for you and will be provided to the department superintendent. Entries that have been registered online must be dropped off on the dates and times below.

E-mailed entries must be received by the Premiums and Awards office by Friday, July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2026 at 2:00 p.m.

Exhibitors can also mail entry forms to Clark County Fair, 17402 NE Delfel Rd, Ridgefield, WA 98642. Your entries will be entered into the online software by a staff member in the Premiums and Awards department. You will receive a confirmation e-mail when this has been completed.

When you enter your exhibits by e-mail, your Exhibitor Number will be assigned to you automatically by the online software. Your entry form and entry tags will be printed for you and will be provided to the department superintendent. Entries that have been e-mailed must be dropped off on the dates and times below.

### **ENTRY FEES**

An entry fee of \$5 per animal must accompany each animal entered.

### **Credit card payments:**

When your entries are received, you will be sent an electronic invoice from Swipe Simple. The invoice can be received by email and/or text message. You will be able to pay your entries fees by credit card using the link in the electronic invoice.

Credit Card payments are also accepted at the Administration Office at the Clark County Fairgrounds. Please call (564) 397-6180 to make your payment by credit card.

### **Check payments:**

### **ENTRIES**

Entries must have registration or recordation papers checked by the Show Secretary before start of shows. Entries must be brought into the barns between 5 a.m. and 8 a.m. Wednesday, August 12<sup>th</sup>, 2026.

### **SPECIFIC RULES**

1. Exhibitors must read the General Rules document that also contains the **General Animal Health Requirements**, available on the Fair's website.
2. The first half of the Open Class Show will begin at 10:00 a.m., Thursday, **August 13, 2026**, consisting of the following breeds, shown in this order: La Mancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Oberhasli.
3. The second half of the Open Class Show will begin at 10:00 a.m., Friday, **August 14, 2026**, consisting of the following breeds shown in this order: AOP, Recorded Grade, Nubian.
4. All open class animals eligible for production awards must have DHIR Individual Lifetime Records or AR\* milker designation on registration papers or proof qualifying in a one-day milking competition.
5. All entries must be shown unless excused by the Barn Superintendent prior to class.

6. Entries shown in group **classes** must have been shown in their individual **class**. Limit of two entries per exhibitor for each group **class**. One exhibitor is limited to two premiums per **class** (classes A-P).
7. Milking and clipping will be done in designated areas or tack.
8. Pen space to be assigned by superintendent. Changes in pen assignments may be made by superintendent approval only.
9. All animals entered must be either naturally polled, dehorned, or disbudded. Large scurs will be discriminated against.
10. No dumping of milk in dry wells is permitted. Offenders will forfeit premiums.
11. Exhibitor is defined as all animals registered and owned under the same ADGA number.
12. Premiums checks will be issued within 60 days after the end of the Fair. Checks not cashed within 120 days of issuance will not be replaced.

#### **Division 100: HERDSMANSHIP**

Herdsmanship awards will be based on general appearance, education displays and cleanliness. All herds will automatically compete. Each exhibitor will decorate and maintain their area between the hours of **9 a.m. to 8 p.m.**

**Class HS:** Small herd, consists of 1 to 12 animals.

**Class HL:** Large herd, consists of 13 or more animals.
