

OPEN CLASS SEWING AND CLOTHING

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ONLINE ENTRIES

Entries can be submitted online at <https://clarkcofair.fairentry.com> beginning on **May 1st, 2026**, and ending on **July 31st, 2026, at 10 p.m.**

When you enter your exhibits online, your Exhibitor Number will be assigned to you automatically by the online software. Your entries will be received by the Premiums and Awards office, and your entry form and entry tags will be printed for you and will be provided to the department superintendent. Entries that have been registered online must be dropped off on the dates and times below.

E-MAIL ENTRIES

Fillable entry forms can be found at www.clarkcofair.com. Exhibitors can fill out their entry form and e-mail the completed form to premiumsandawards@clarkcofair.com. E-mailed entries must be received by the Premiums and Awards office by Friday, July 31st at 10 p.m. Your entries will be entered into the online software by a staff member in the Premiums and Awards department. You will receive a confirmation e-mail when this has been completed.

When you enter your exhibits by e-mail, your Exhibitor Number will be assigned to you automatically by the online software. Your entry form and entry tags will be printed for you and will be provided to the department superintendent. Entries that have been e-mailed must be dropped off on the dates and times below.

WALK-IN ENTRIES

Exhibitors can also submit entries in person on **Monday, August 3rd between 10 am and 6 pm, and on Tuesday, August 4th and Wednesday, August 5th between 10 am and 8 pm. No entries will be accepted on Thursday, August 6th or Friday, August 7th.** If you plan to submit your entries

in person, you will need to call the Fair Office at (564) 397-6180 during regular business hours after May 1st to request an Exhibitor Number.

ENTRY DROP OFF

Entries must be dropped off on **Monday, August 3 between 10 am and 6 pm** and on **Tuesday, August 4 and Wednesday, August 5 between 10 am and 8 pm.**

ENTRY INFORMATION

1. This Department is open to anyone who wishes to enter. No entry fee will be charged, or admission tickets given to exhibitors.
2. No exhibit can be removed before 10 p.m. Sunday, **August 16**. If any article is removed prior to that time, the exhibitor will forfeit the ribbon and premium for such article. Pickup time Sunday, **August 16, 2026**, from 10 p.m. to 11 p.m., and Monday, **August 17, 2026**, from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. (Noon).
3. Entries in this department must be homemade and entered in the name of the designer. No previously exhibited entry can compete for premiums.
4. All entries must have been completed after **August 11, 2025**.

SPECIFIC RULES

1. Please also see the **General Rules** of the Fair.
2. Only those items for which there is a Division and Class number can be entered.
3. Maximum twenty-five (25) total entries per exhibitor. If entries exceed the twenty-five (25) entry limit, entries may be accepted as “display only”, solely at the discretion of the Superintendent.
4. A collection or set (an assemblage of cohesive items) may be entered as one (1) set, or one (1) collection. Alternatively, the exhibitor may choose to enter items as individual entries, keeping in mind the twenty-five (25) entry total.
5. No soiled articles will be accepted. The superintendent reserves the right to reject such articles.
6. No exhibits can be removed before 10 p.m., **Sunday, August 16**. If any article is removed prior to that time, the exhibitor will forfeit the ribbon and premium for such article.
7. The Fair Association will not be responsible for exhibits but will use every precaution to protect them from loss or damage.
8. The Superintendent reserves the right to reject all articles for exhibit at their discretion.
9. Youth = up to age 18, Adult = 19 and over
10. **SPECIAL AWARD:** An Elsie Thompson Award will be awarded to 1 Youth and 1 Adult. This consists of a Special Rosette and a \$10.00 award to 1 Youth and 1 Adult respectively awarded by the department superintendents for the best use of recycled materials used to make something new. Each Elsie Thompson award must be an entry entered into the **Recycled Divisions of 711 or 712**. These entries must follow the **Recycled Division 711 and 712** guidelines.
11. “Tailored” items entered in Classes 234-246; you must detail what was tailored.

SPECIAL AWARD, MADE FOR CHARITY

Any item made for charity receives a special ribbon, no money awards. If you are entering your items in person, add the letter “C” to your entry form for each charitable contribution. Use a separate entry form for these items. If you are entering your items online, indicate your donation to charity in the item description. No limit to number of exhibits. Please include a label with the size for each garment.

If the exhibitor does not wish to receive a tax receipt, they may turn the items over to the department superintendent, who will donate the items after the conclusion of the Fair. These items become the property of CCF for distribution to Clark County non-profit agencies.

If the exhibitor wishes to receive a donation receipt for their items, they will need to take the item to a qualifying charity after the Fair and receive a tax receipt directly from the charitable organization.

PREMIUMS

Best of Division Rosettes will be awarded to 1 Adult and 1 Youth of the following divisions: Machine Sewing, Hand Sewing, Crocheting, Knitting, Felted/Woven, Home Spun Yarn, Wearable Art, Machine Embroidery, Hand Embroidery, Fashion Design, Clothing Education Exhibit.

Blue ribbon = 10 points, Red ribbon = 8 points, White ribbon = 4 points

Premiums checks will be issued within 60 days after the end of the Fair. Checks not cashed within 120 days of issuance will not be replaced.

Recycled items must adhere to the following rules to be in the running for the Special awarded Elsie Thompson \$10.00 award along with a Special rosette.

1. Items must be accompanied by a picture, a duplicate, or a special display of the original materials.
2. Must have something indicating what the item was made from (i.e. a dress made from drapes, a vest made from jeans, etc.).
3. Attach (safety pin) a 2” X 2” label stating, “Recycled Project.”
4. Must be a new item, not an alteration for size, etc.
5. Judging of best entry will be done by Judge Panel and Division Superintendents
