- 2. Participants will apply what they've learned as they provide information about food/nutrition-related displays.
- 3. Intermediates and Seniors will be asked to give oral reasons in one class. A "Best Oral Reasons" Rosette ribbon will be awarded at both the Intermediate and Senior levels.

Sign up during Fair in the 4-H Kitchen area with Nancy Peck, Sunday, August 11 from 10-11 pm or Monday, August 12 from 9 am to Noon. Participating as a member of an ineligible team may result in disqualification of all members.
