ONLINE ENTRIES

Entries can be submitted online at <https://clarkcofair.fairentry.com> beginning on **May 1st, 2026**, and ending on **July 15th, 2026, at 10 p.m.**

When you enter your exhibits online, your Exhibitor Number will be assigned to you automatically by the online software. Your entries will be received by the Premiums and Awards office, and your entry form and entry tags will be printed for you and will be provided to the department superintendent. Entries that have been registered online must be dropped off on the dates and times below.

Fillable entry forms can be found at www.clarkcofair.com. Exhibitors can fill out their entry form and e-mail the completed form to premiumsandawards@clarkcofair.com. E-mailed entries must be received by the Premiums and Awards office by Friday, July 15th, 2026 at 2:00 p.m. Exhibitors can also mail entry forms to Clark County Fair, 17402 NE Delfel Rd, Ridgefield, WA 98642. Your entries will be entered into the online software by a staff member in the Premiums and Awards department. You will receive a confirmation e-mail when this has been completed.

When you enter your exhibits by e-mail, your Exhibitor Number will be assigned to you automatically by the online software. Your entry form and entry tags will be printed for you and will be provided to the department superintendent. Entries that have been e-mailed must be dropped off on the dates and times below.

ENTRY FEES

Stall fees: \$10 must accompany each animal entered.

Credit card payments:

When your entries are received, you will be sent an electronic invoice from Swipe Simple. The invoice can be received by email and/or text message. You will be able to pay your entries fees by credit card using the link in the electronic invoice.

Credit Card payment are also accepted at the Administration Office at the Clark County Fairgrounds. Please call (564) 397-6180 to make your payment by credit card.

Hay: Grass hay will be provided by the Fair.

SPECIFIC RULES

1. Exhibitors must read the General Rules document that also contains the **General Animal Health Requirements**, available on the Fair's website.
2. Beef cattle can arrive on **Thursday, August 6th** after 12:00 p.m. (noon).
3. The number of animals an exhibitor may stall will be limited by available space.
4. Animals showing in breed classes must be registered in the recognized breed association of the division. (Example: Hereford animals must be registered in the Hereford Association)
5. To be eligible to enter a group class, an animal must also be shown as an individual.
6. Group classes may be composed of animals kept on the same farm yet owned by different members of the family unit. Please list each group class on an entry form.
7. All breeds wanting breed promotion space in the beef building must submit their requests by **Monday, July 6, 2026**. Regular stall fees must be paid. Stall space used for other than exhibit of animals shall be up to the discretion of the superintendent.
8. Herdsmanship awards will be given, based on observance of exhibits throughout the Fair for cleanliness and attractiveness of animals and stalls, as well as courtesy and neatness of attendant.
9. Exhibitors finding mistakes in premiums paid must report them to the Premium & Awards Office within 30 days, or no adjustment can be made.

10. Premiums checks will be issued within 60 days after the end of the Fair. Checks not cashed within 120 days of issuance will not be replaced.
11. For a breed to have their own breed show, there must be a minimum of five (5) animals.
12. Mini breeds are not eligible for Supreme classes.
