ONLINE ENTRIES

Entries can be submitted online at <https://clarkcofair.fairentry.com> beginning on **May 1st, 2026**, and ending on **July 15th, 2026, at 10 p.m.**

When you enter your exhibits online, your Exhibitor Number will be assigned to you automatically by the online software. Your entries will be received by the Premiums and Awards office, and your entry form and entry tags will be printed for you and will be provided to the department superintendent. Entries that have been registered online must be dropped off on the dates and times below.

E-MAIL/MAIL ENTRIES

Fillable entry forms can be found at www.clarkcofair.com. Exhibitors can fill out their entry form and e-mail the completed form to premiumsandawards@clarkcofair.com. E-mailed entries must be received by the Premiums and Awards office by Friday, July 15th, 2026 at 2:00 p.m. Exhibitors can also mail entry forms to Clark County Fair, 17402 NE Delfel Rd, Ridgefield, WA 98642. Your entries will be entered into the online software by a staff member in the Premiums and Awards department. You will receive a confirmation e-mail when this has been completed.

When you enter your exhibits by e-mail, your Exhibitor Number will be assigned to you automatically by the online software. Your entry form and entry tags will be printed for you and will be provided to the department superintendent. Entries that have been e-mailed must be dropped off on the dates and times below.

ENTRY FEES

The entry fee is \$5 per animal for Dual Fair Show.

Credit card payments:

When your entries are received, you will be sent an electronic invoice from Swipe Simple. The invoice can be received by email and/or text message. You will be able to pay your entries fees by credit card using the link in the electronic invoice.

ENTRIES

Entries must be checked into the barn between 5 a.m. and 8 a.m., **Wednesday, August 12, 2026**. Entries will be released on Sunday evening, August 16, 2026. All exhibitors in this department are responsible for reading and complying with the **General Rules** and the special rules and regulations of this department.

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Exhibitors must read the General Rules document that also contains the **General Animal Health Requirements**, available on the Fair's website.
2. Entries for the Dual Fair Show will be postmarked or turned into the Fair office by **Wednesday, July 15, 2026**.
3. Pen space will be assigned by the Superintendent according to availability. Priority will be given to Clark County residents and previous Clark County Fair exhibitors.
4. All entries must be in place by 9 a.m., Wednesday, August **12, 2026**.
5. ABGA rules shall govern.
6. All entries must have verification as registered by the ABGA database or a stamped registration application checked by the Asst. Superintendent before the start of the show. Exhibits must have readable tattoos and matching registration certificate, or the animal will be disqualified.
7. All animals must conform to breed standards.
8. Show Schedule:

JUDGING: Saturday, August **15**, at 10:30 a.m., - Dual ABGA Show and Group Classes
All entries must be shown in both shows.

9. The dress code for handlers will consist of neat and tidy collared shirt, dark pants, and closed toe shoes.
10. Any animal shown in a group class must have been shown in individual classes. There will be no limit on entries for an exhibitor in individual classes. It will be the responsibility of the exhibitor to have handlers for each entry shown. There will be a limit of two entries per exhibitor for group classes, except Best Exhibitor Trio, which is limited to one entry per exhibitor.
11. All exhibitors will be limited to two premiums per Classes A through M per Fair show.
12. Premiums checks will be issued within 60 days after the end of the Fair. Checks not cashed within 120 days of issuance will not be replaced.
13. Individual division with over 16 entries will be split at the discretion of the judge.
14. All entries must be shown unless excused by the Superintendent prior to division.
15. Entries will be released Sunday evening, **August 16, 2026**.
16. There will be an intermission during the Saturday show when 4-H Market goats are in the ring at the Junior Livestock Auction. This allows our exhibitors to support our 4-H Market Goat Program.

Division 100: HERDSMANSHIP

Each exhibitor is responsible for decorating and maintaining their assigned pen space, tack area, and aisle area in a clean and orderly manner from 9 a.m. until 8 p.m. daily. Herdsmanship awards will be based on general appearance, educational displays, and cleanliness.

Class HS: Small herd = 1 – 5 goats

Class HL: Large herd = 6+ goats
