Division 102: Adult Non-commercial


Division 103: Commercial

Class A - Soft (Neuchatel, Cottage, Ricotta)

Class B - Pressed Fresh (Mozzarella, pressed and not aged)

Class C - Aged (anything aged over 60 days)

Class D - Mold Ripened (Blue, Brie, Camembert)



Contest Rules

1. All entries (4-6 oz. each) must use pasteurized goat's milk.
2. All entries become the property of the Clark County Goat Association. Containers will not be returned.
3. Entries will be accepted: Saturday, August 8, 2026, 10 a.m. to noon, Youth—4-H Eligible (up to 18 or final year in 4-H).
4. Entries will be judged at 12:30 p.m. on August 8, 2026 for premium points. Entries that are awarded a Blue Ribbon will be judged by Local Celebrities at 3:30 p.m. for additional awards and prizes.
5. Commercial cheesemakers must be licensed by the Department of Agriculture and are required to submit their plant number with entries.
6. Limit 5 entries per person, per division.

Premiums and Awards

- Premiums: Blue ribbon - 6 points; Red ribbon - 4 points; White ribbon - 2 points
- Judge's Choice - 1 rosette will be awarded in each class
- Best in Division - 1 rosette will be awarded in each division
- Featured Cheese - 1 rosette will be awarded to an entry from the Featured Cheese type in each division
- Best in Show - 1 rosette will be awarded overall
- Local Celebrity Judges - Local celebrities will judge the Blue Ribbon cheeses and will award a 1st Place, 2nd Place and 3rd Place in each Division. Entries in Divisions 101 and 102 will receive a rosette and cash prizes: First \$15, Second \$10, Third \$7.50. Entries in Division 103 will receive a rosette.

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
