- 3. International cookbook made by exhibitor. Minimum of 15 recipes.
- 4. Informational display (22" x 28") on one specific country or culture.
- 5. Article of clothing made by exhibitor, representing another country or culture.
- 6. Model of village found in another country.

7. Any other exhibit related to project showing initiative, originality, and accomplishment. Points awarded by judge.
