Animal Fair Entries can be submitted online at <https://clarkcofair.fairentry.com> ending on the last business day of June. Please log-in to Fairentry with your 4-Honline credentials, you do not need to create an account to submit 4-H Horse Exhibit entries.

Each 4-H member showing in this department is responsible for reading and complying with the General Rules for the Clark County Fair (beginning of Exhibitor Handbook), the 4- H Rules and Regulations printed at the beginning of 4-H section, and the special rules and regulations of this department.

### **Rules & Regulations**

1. All entries must be submitted online in Fairentry by 5pm, the last working day of June, 2026. No late entries will be accepted – no exceptions.
2. ASTM-SEI #1163 approved helmets are mandatory for all exhibitors.
3. Showmanship is mandatory for every horse and rider.
4. Member can only enter a class one time.
5. State Fair participants:
  - a. Must use the same horse they qualified on at the Clark County Fair Division for the State Fair Class.
  - b. Can only enter in classes they participated in at the Clark County Fair.
6. Refer to the most current copies of Washington State 4-H Equine Program Rule Book and the Clark County Washington 4-H Horse Project Supplemental Rule Book.

### **DIVISION 250 : HERDSMANSHIP**

Use Clark County Fair Livestock entry form to fill out Herdsmanship Premium request, with Club name as it appears on the club checking/savings account. Premium will not be granted without the submitted paperwork. Premium will be mailed in c/o General Club Leader Paperwork must be turned into the 4-H office at the Clark County Fair no later than the last day of Fair.
