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### ONLINE ENTRIES

Entries can be submitted online at <https://clarkcofair.fairentry.com> beginning on **May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2026**, and ending on **July 31<sup>st</sup>, 2026, at 10 p.m.**

When you enter your exhibits online, your Exhibitor Number will be assigned to you automatically by the online software. Your entries will be received by the Premiums and Awards office, and your entry form and entry tags will be printed for you and will be provided to the department superintendent. Entries that have been registered online must be dropped off on the dates and times below.

### E-MAIL ENTRIES

Exhibitors can fill out their entry form and e-mail the completed form to [premiumsandawards@clarkcofair.com](mailto:premiumsandawards@clarkcofair.com). E-mailed entries must be received by the Premiums and Awards office by **Friday, July 31<sup>st</sup> at 10 p.m.** Your entries will be entered into the online software by a staff member in the Premiums and Awards department. You will receive a confirmation e-mail when this has been completed.

When you enter your exhibits by e-mail, your Exhibitor Number will be assigned to you automatically by the online software. Your entry form and entry tags will be printed for you and will be provided to the department superintendent. Entries that have been e-mailed must be dropped off on the dates and times below.

### WALK-IN ENTRIES

Exhibitors can also submit entries in person on **Thursday, August 6 from 3 p.m. until 7 p.m.** If you plan to submit your entries in person, you will need to call the Fair Office at (564) 397-6180 during regular business hours after May 1<sup>st</sup> to request an Exhibitor Number.

You will also need to bring two copies of the Still Exhibits Entry Form when you drop off your entries. Please fill out the forms as completely as possible prior to arrival to expedite the processing. Copies of the form may be obtained from the Fair's website at [www.clarkcofair.com](http://www.clarkcofair.com) under the Exhibitors tab.

### **ENTRY DROP OFF**

Entries must be dropped off on **Thursday, August 6 from 3 p.m. until 7 p.m.** The Secretary may allow accommodations for heat-sensitive entries such as creamed honey.

### **SPECIFIC RULES**

1. **GENERAL:** All exhibitors are bound by the General Rules document available on the Fair's website, as well as by the following conditions set for this department.
2. All entries must be the product of the person placing the entry. The only exception to this rule would be in Classes T and U; the products entered here may be from other producers, but must be honey, wax, food, craft, or other products relating to the beekeeping industry. Display material/baskets and/or appropriate packaging is accepted.
3. One entry per class, per person.
4. Exhibit must be produced within 12 months prior to the show.
5. No identifying labels shall be attached to the entries.
6. Each entrant or their designated representative will be responsible for delivering his/her entries to the Secretary at the Bee Barn booth on entry day and picking up their entries at the Bee Barn on **Monday, August 17<sup>th</sup> between 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. (noon).**
7. The Clark County Beekeepers Association will not be responsible for entries left after noon August 17<sup>th</sup> without prior arrangement.
8. CLASS: A - E Glass Queen line jars, no plastic.
9. CLASS: F and G must be in bee-proof containers wrapped in heavy-duty plastic film.
10. CLASS: J – L must be wrapped in heavy-duty plastic film.

### **PREMIUM SCHEDULE**

Trophies and ribbons will be awarded based on a point system. Trophies are awarded on a revolving basis.

### **RIBBONS:**

Blue ribbon: scores of 90 points or greater

Red ribbon: scores of between 80 – 89 points

White ribbon: scores of 79 points and below

### **TROPHIES:**

Best of Show - By choice of judges

Sweepstakes - Most overall points from all classes

Superintendent's Choice – By choice of Superintendent

### **DIVISION 90: Beekeeping & Honey**

#### CLASS LIST FOR DIVISION 90:

- A. Honey, extracted water white** - Two 1-pound Queen line jars
- B. Honey, extracted white** - Two 1-pound Queen line jars
- C. Honey, extracted extra light amber** - Two 1-pound Queen line jars
- D. Honey, extracted light amber** - Two 1-pound Queen line jars
- E. Honey, extracted dark amber** - Two 1-pound Queen line jars
- F. Boxes or Rounds of Honeycomb** - Two section boxes or rounds
- G. Cut-comb Honey, any color** - Two sections of cut-comb honey
- H. Chunk Honey** - Two uniform jars of chunk honey
- I. Creamed Honey** - Two uniform jars of creamed honey
- J. Western Extracting Frame of Honey** - One western extracting frame of honey
- K. Shallow Extracting Frame of Honey** - One shallow extracting frame of honey
- L. Deep Extracting Frame of Honey** - One deep extracting frame of honey
- M. Beeswax, Natural** - One 1-Pound single block pure beeswax, natural
- N. Beeswax Candles, Dipped** - One pair, pure beeswax
- O. Beeswax Candles, Molded** – One pair, any design, pure beeswax
- P. Beeswax Candles, Rolled** - One pair, pure beeswax
- Q. Beeswax Novelty Item** - Any design, pure beeswax
- R. Mixed Pollen, Dried** - Three uniform jars of mixed pollen (dried)
- S. Pie or Cake** - Made with honey as the only sweetener
- T. Muffins or Bread** - Three muffins or one loaf of bread with honey as the only sweetener
- U. Cookies or Candies** - 5 or 6 pieces with honey as the only sweetener
- V. Gift Basket** - One gift basket of honey or honey-related products
- W. Display** - One display of honey or honey-related products
- X. Miscellaneous** - Item made from bee products such as lip balm, soap, material for braces, etc.
- Y. Educational Display or Poster** - made by the exhibitor, related to beekeeping, honey or pollinators.
- Z. Observation Hive** - One observation hive with live bees. Constructed to accommodate one frame of brood and one frame of honey/pollen. Must have a marked queen to be considered for judging.
- AA. Specialty Hive** - One specialty hive, with no bees. Constructed to accommodate a minimum of ten standard frames. May be made to not look like a standard beehive. Example: A house or barn, etc.
- BB. Canned Goods** - Canned goods, Sauces, Jellies, Jams with Honey as the main sweetener
- CC. Original Artwork** - made by the exhibitor, related to beekeeping, honey or pollinators.
