## **Division 308: PLANT SCIENCES**

Judging in the Plant Sciences contest will be based on established standards. Please be prepared to make arrangements to replace perishable items submitted in Classes 2-4 halfway through fair, so that the exhibits may always look their best.

## Class 1: Container Garden

A container garden including any living plant, i.e., flowers, herbs, and/or vegetables. For an herb container, you must have a minimum of four varieties in the container or garden. Containers over 4 square feet require pre-approval from Grange Youth Still Exhibit Superintendent to ensure space allocation and support for proper care of display. Points:

a - Under 2 square feet: Blue 20, Red 15, White 8 b - Over 2 square feet: Blue 25, Red 20, White 15

Class 2: Vegetable

Class 3: Fruit

Class 4: Fresh Cut Floral

Class 5: Forest Trees and Plants in Container

Class 6: Plant Propagation/Tree Grafting

All produce, flowers, forest trees and plants, and propagated plants/tree grafts exhibited for classes 2-6 must be grown by the Grange Youth. Immature melons, pumpkins, or winter squash are not acceptable for exhibit. Containers should be appropriate to the product for display.

Points: Blue 8, Red 6, White 4
