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**RULES & REGULATIONS:**

Open to members enrolled in the 4H Project Citizenship & Global Citizenship Projects Exhibit must be accompanied by 3"x 5" card explaining exhibit and the country or culture it represents. Emphasis must be on Citizenship & Global Citizenship (on both the cards and exhibits.) Exhibitor may enter six (6) exhibits, one item per class.

**Points:** Blue 10, Red 8, White 6

**CLASS:**

1. Any art project representing another country or culture.
2. Homemade game from another country or culture. Include rules on how to play.
3. International cookbook made by exhibitor. Minimum of 15 recipes.
4. Informational display (22" x 28") on one specific country or culture.
5. Article of clothing made by exhibitor, representing another country or culture.
