RULES & REGULATIONS:

1. All entries must be sent to the WSU/Clark County Extension Office by 5 pm the last day of June 2021. Late entries will not be accepted.
2. ASTM-SEI #1163 approved helmets are mandatory for all exhibitors
3. Fitting & Showing is mandatory for every horse in every event.
Prequalifying is mandatory for trail.
4. Member can only enter a class once.
5. State Fair participants
 - a. Must use the same horse they qualified on at the Clark County Fair Division for the State Fair Class.
 - b. Can only enter in classes they participated in at the Clark County Fair.
 - c. Must attend or be represented at the mandatory state team meeting to complete paperwork.
