- 3. Fitting & Showing is mandatory for every horse in every event. Prequalifying is mandatory for trail.
- 4. Member can only enter a class once.
- 5. State Fair participants
 - a. Must use the same horse they qualified on at the Clark County Fair Division for the State Fair Class.
 - b. Can only enter in classes they participated in at the Clark County Fair.
 - c. Must attend or be represented at the mandatory state team meeting to complete paperwork.
