Good News...You're invited to participate! You can apply to enter the parade by submitting the application by **July 12, 2022**. The Clark County Fair Parade Committee will review all entries to determine the final choices for the lineup. Apply early as space is limited. We are looking for creativity and fun ideas using our theme of **#WorthTheWait**. There is **NO ENTRY FEE** to join the parade so bring us your best ideas!

Entry Categories

- *Fair Participants* – departments, vendors, groups, associations
- *Clark County Fair Sponsors*
- *Non-Commercial Fair-Related Entries* – kids, families, groups

Type of Entry

- Entertainment – clowns, jugglers, street musicians (able to perform while walking)
- Floats – pulled displays (no longer than 15 feet) – can use golf cart/ATV to pull the float and we will make sure that spectators on the route are not in the way of turning vehicles
- Marching – drill teams, bands
- Kids – groups of kids (with 1 adult chaperone per 10 kids) with bikes, trikes, wagons, pulled displays, etc.
- No leashed animals allowed – Caged animals permitted

Rules and Regulations for Participants

The Clark County Fair Association and the Clark County Fair Parade Committee reserve the right to remove any entry from the parade, either prior to the start of the parade, during the parade or before Fair dates. Any Entry, not following instructions or conforming to the rules, will be removed from the parade.

- All entries must be Fair related and themed to #WorththeWait.
- Parade entries must follow the directions of the parade monitors and officials.
- All entries must be appropriate for a family audience and Fair goers.
- All floats are required to have 4 walkers (two on each side) to prevent Fair goers from sitting, climbing or boarding the floats.
- All kids participating in a group function must have adult supervision consisting of one adult per 10 kids.
- No physical contact is allowed with Fair goers; this includes the throwing of candy, literature, or other items.
- Entry is not allowed to focus on religious, political, ideological or controversial themes. Use of political signs, social or political material or improper use of the American Flag is not permitted.
- All parade participants must keep pace with the line of march, no stragglers. Spacing is very important; you must keep your spacing no more than 10 feet behind your lead.
- No alcohol, controlled substances or marijuana, is to be on display or used on floats, motorized vehicles or displays.
- Float Requirements: Maximum width of the float is 8 feet; maximum length is 15 feet. Float must be at least 10 inches off the ground for any clearance issues. Maximum height of the float can be 12 feet.
