## ENTRY INFORMATION

1. This Department is open to anyone who wishes to enter. No entry fee will be charged or admission tickets given to exhibitors.
2. Entries accepted: Tuesday, August 2, and Wednesday, August 3, 10 a.m. to 8 p.m. No entries accepted Thursday, August 4.
3. No exhibit can be removed before 10 p.m. Sunday, August 14. If any article is removed prior to that time, the exhibitor will forfeit the ribbon and premium for such article. Pickup time Sunday, August 14, 2022 from 10 p.m. to 11 p.m., and Monday, August 15, 2022 from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. (Noon).
4. Entries in this department must be homemade and entered in the name of the designer. No previously exhibited entry can compete for premiums.
5. All entries must have been completed after August 11, 2020.

## SPECIFIC RULES

1. Please also see the **General Rules** of the Fair.
2. Only those items for which there is a Division and Class number can be entered. One (1) entry per Class per exhibitor, maximum twenty five (25) total entries. A collection or set (an assemblage of cohesive items) may be entered as one (1) set, or one (1) collection. Alternatively the exhibitor may choose to enter items as individual entries, keeping in mind the twenty five (25) entry total. (If entries exceed the twenty five (25) entry limit, entries may be accepted as "display only", solely at the discretion of the Superintendent).
3. No soiled articles will be accepted. The superintendent reserves the right to reject such articles.
4. No exhibits can be removed before 10 p.m., Sunday, August 14. If any article is removed prior to that time, the exhibitor will forfeit the ribbon and premium for such article.
5. The Fair Association will not be responsible for exhibits but will use every precaution to protect them from loss or damage.
6. The Superintendent reserves the right to reject all articles for exhibit at her discretion.
7. Youth = Under 10 years of age  
Junior = 11-18 years of age  
Adult = 19-54 years of age  
Senior = 55+ years of age.

Any garment made and donated for charity receives a special ribbon and tax receipt but no money awards. Items become the property of CCFA for distribution to Clark County non-profit agencies. The current Classes will be preceded by the letter "C" for these items. No limit to number of exhibits. Exhibitors may select recipient agency.
